







#### **Step SEVEN**

## Keep your account secure

## Set up two-factor authentication with a thirdparty app



At this point it will ask you to download a third party authenticator app.

As part of our continuous efforts to keep your personal health data secure, we've introduced a new layer of security verification in your Patient Access account. You'll need to choose a third party authenticator app. You can get these free as extensions for web browsers or as apps from the Apple App Store for iOS devices, the Mac App Store for MacOS, the Google Play Store for Android devices, or Microsoft Store for Windows. What are third party authenticator apps?
